Head Basketball Coach at Wisconsin Badgers, WI

Mar 2023 - Present

- Led the team to a Big Ten Conference Championship in 2015, finishing with an overall record of 31-3 and a conference record of 16-2.
- Guided the team to the NCAA Final Four in 2014 and 2015, becoming the first Wisconsin coach to reach back-to-back Final Fours since the tournament expanded to 64 teams in 1985.
- Achieved a program-record 36 wins during the 2014-15 season, culminating in a national championship game appearance against Duke.
- Developed and coached two consensus First-Team All-Americans in Frank Kaminsky (2015) and Ethan Happ (2019), along with multiple All-Big Ten selections throughout his tenure.

Assistant Basketball Coach at Marquette Golden Eagles, WI

Aug 2022 - Feb 2023

- Led the team to achieve a 24-10 win-loss record in the 2018-2019 season, resulting in an NCAA Tournament appearance for the first time since 2013.
- Developed and implemented new offensive and defensive strategies that increased the team's average points per game by 10%, from 75.6 in the previous season to 82.9, ranking them among the top 20 offenses in the nation.
- Mentored and coached a player who went on to receive the Big East Player of the Year award, as well as two players who were named to the All-Big East First Team, showcasing the positive impact on player development and performance.
